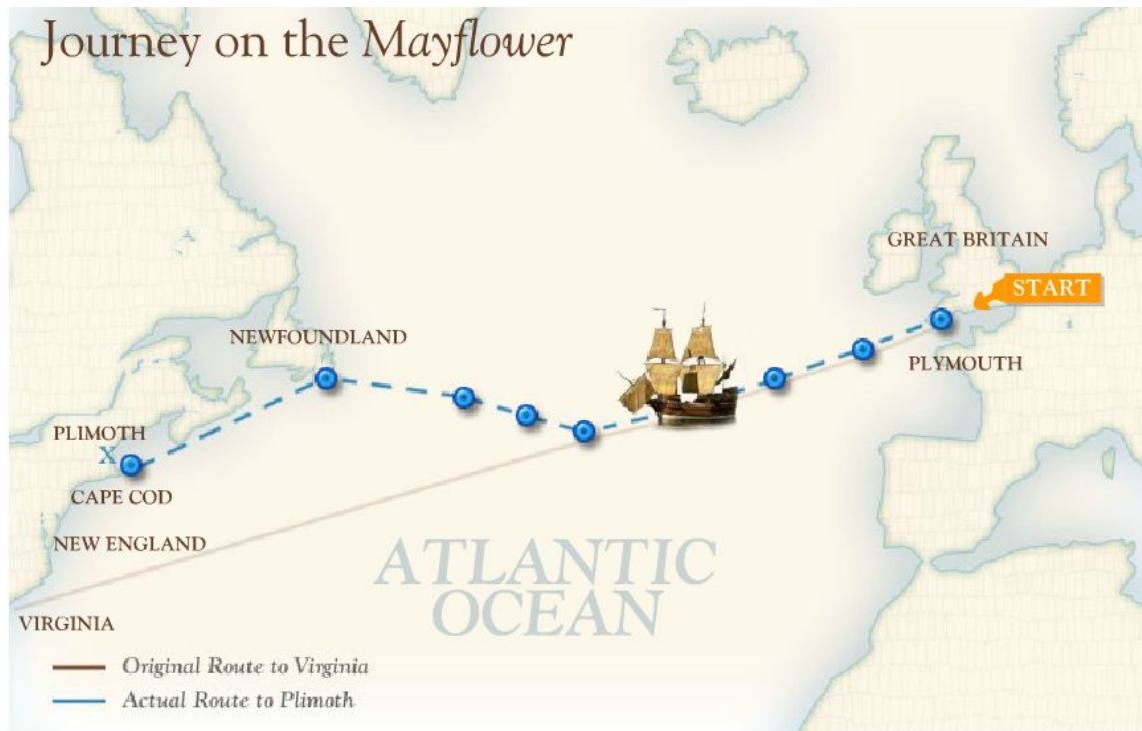
Native Americans & Pilgrims
